Consumer waste doesn't sound promising as a raw material for furniture – if anything you'd expect something the delicate shade of sludge. It comes as a surprise to find furniture made from recycled plastic board that is as brightly splattered with colour as a Jackson Pollock

painting. Available from Made of Waste, the boards are made from plastic bottles which are chopped up and compressed into sheets. What goes in influences the end product, so bottles can be sorted to produce different colour combinations to order. Designer Jane Atfield set up the company to supply recycled materials after experimenting with them while she was at the Royal College of Art. 'Waste is always different,' says Atfield.
